

Mansarovar Tour (Via Kerung)



Trip Overview

Kailash in Tibet means the treasure of the snow-capped mountain. It is one of the most sacred peaks in the world with more than 1200 KM from Lhasa and has been one of the must-visit destinations for any Tibet tour in recent years. A trip here wonderfully integrates the spiritual, cultural, and physical dimensions of any trip to Tibet. Being able to meet pilgrims from across Tibet and other countries is one of the alluring factors of this tour.

Hinduism, Tibetan Buddhism, Bon- native religion in Tibet, and Jainism recognize it as the center of the world. Indians also think that this is the center of the world. They think Lord Shiva lives here, who has the strongest mantra and the highest position. Mt Kailash Kora is 52 KM long and usually takes 3 days to complete. Altitude ranges from 4675 Mtr at Darchen the starting point to 5630 Mtr at Dolmi Ri, the highest point of Kora. The Kora(Circuit) around Mt Kailash is one of the most important pilgrimages in Asia. It has been a religious sanctuary since pre-Buddhist times. Pilgrims of Hindu, Buddhist, Jain, and Bon believe that one kora around Mt Kailash cleans sins of this lifetime, 108 Kora breaks the cycle of rebirth and assures one of nirvana at death. The kora is made in a clockwise direction by Hindus and Buddhists but counterclockwise by followers of the Jain and Bon religions. This is one of the lifetime memorable tours in the Himalayas. There are many routes to get to Mount Kailash (Mansarovar) and we the Khumbu Alpine Travel have been organizing different routes as per the desires and requirements of customers. You can choose whichever is easier and comfort for you. Cost determination will depend on group size and route.

Trip Itinerary

- Day 1 - Kathmandu Arrival
- Day 2 - Kathmandu Sightseeing
- Day 3 - Drive to Dhunche (2000m / 130 km / 6 hrs) or Syabrubesi (1600m / 145 km / 6.5 hrs)
- Day 4 - Drive to Kerung County. Drive to Rasuwagadhi (1800m / 15 km / 45 min from Syabrubesi), (3950m) – 3 hrs / 105 km.
- Day 5 - Drive to Saga (100 km – 5hrs).
- Day 6 - Drive from Saga to Mansarovar Lake (450km – 7 – 8hrs)
- Day 7 - Drive to Darchen (2hrs).
- Day 8 - First Day of Outer Kora – Trek to Dirapuk
- Day 9 - Second Day of Outer Kora – On to Zuthulphuk with Trek to Dolma La Pass
- Day 10 - Drive to Saga
- Day 11 - Drive back to Kerung
- Day 12 - Drive to Kathmandu 10 hr / 265 km.
- Day 13 - Transfer to Kathmandu Airport
