Trip Overview

Mera Peak is an exciting, scenic, and highest trekking peak in Nepal becoming popular among trekkers and climbers. It is suitable for all trekkers who dare to dream of standing on the Himalayas and getting an opportunity to explore the panoramic view of all the highest peaks around. Technically it is not that difficult but altitude is out there demanding on account of the altitude and our itinerary has been carefully designed for proper acclimatization for the climbers. Our trip begins following a short and exciting flight to the Tenzing Hillary Airport in Lukla and continues walks of several days that will take us to the area of Mera Valley.

Trip Itinerary

- Day 1 - Arrival in Kathmandu and transfer to hotel (1400 Mtr/4592 Ft)
- Day 2 - Sighseeing in Kathmandu
- Day 3 - Schedule flight to Lukla and Trek to Paiya (2800 Mtr/9184 Ft)
- Day 4 - Trek to Pangom(2850 Mtr/9348 Ft)
- Day 5 - Duration: 5 hours trek Walking Dis: 8.6 KM Elevation gain :50 Mtr
Our day start with walking in the rhododendron and bamboo forest.it takes 5 hours to get Pangom.
- Day 6 - Trek to Chatrakhola(3150 Mtr/10332 Ft)
- Day 7 - Trek to Kothe(3550 Mtr/11644 Ft)
- Day 8 - Trek to Thagnag(4300 Mtr/14104 Ft)
- Day 9 - Trek to Khare(5000 Mtr/16400 Ft)
- Day 10 - Acclimatization Day in Khare
- Day 11 - Trek to Mera Highcamp(5800 Mtr/19024 Ft)
- Day 12 - Mera Summit and Back Down to Khare
- Day 13 - Trek to Kothe (3550 Mtr/11644 Ft)
- Day 14 - Trek to Chatra La/Thuli Kharka (4300 Mtr/14104 Ft)

- Day 15 - Trek to Lukla (2610 Mtr/8560 Ft)
- Day 16 - Scheduled Flight to Kathmandu
- Day 17 - Liesure day in Kathmandu
- Day 18 - Flight Back to home
- Day 19 - Flight Back to home
